Chains

- Soil, shallow, loose, sand and clay loam, mixed with decomposed limestone and lava; 3rd rate.
- Undergrowth, dense shadscale, rabbit and sagebrush.
- No timber.
- Fair grazing.

- DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SUBDIVISION, T. 41 N.; R. 22 E.
REESTABLISHMENT OF SURVEYES EXECUTED BY GARSIDE AND PREBLE UNDER CONTRACT NO. 61, IN YEAR 1874.
- From the cor. secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, on the E. bdy. of the township, heretofore described.
- West, on retracement line bet. secs. 13 and 24.
- 40.00 Record course and distance; find no trace of the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. secs. 13 and 24.
- Continue on same line with continuous measurement.
- 83.47 Fall 270 lks. S. of the original cor. secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, hereinafter described.
- The course of this mile therefore is, N. $88^{\circ}09'$ W., and the distance for each half mile is 41.755 chs.
- Thence,
- From the cor. secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24.
- N. $88^{\circ}09'$ W., on resurvey line along the S. bdy. sec. 13.
- Over rolling mountainous land through dense undergrowth.
- 1.80 Point of spur, projects N. 20° E.
- 2.80 Ravine, drains NE.
- 14.30 Edge of table land, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.
- 25.30 Rocky outcropping at edge of table land, bears S. and N. 20° W.
- 32.46 Ravine, drains NE.
- 37.30 Edge of table land, bears NE. and SW.
- 41.22 Point easting of 40.00 chs. from the point for the cor. secs. 14 and 24.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 24 only, with brass cap marked.
