

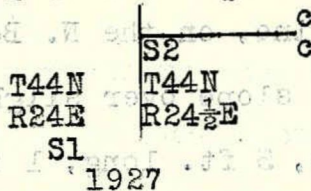
Independent Resurvey of the N. Boundary of fractional
T. 44 N., R. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E

Chains Raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of the cor., also deposit a lava rock, 8x6x5 ins., marked with a cross (x) on one face at base of monument.
Land: slightly rolling mesa.
Soil: heavy clay containing some rock.
Undergrowth: sage. Fair growth of grass.

West on a true line, on the N. Bdy. of sec. 2.
Asc. gradual E. slope over slightly rolling mesa.
3.30 Dry spring, bears N. about 2 chs. distant.
9.30 Low spur, projects S., gradually descend W. slope.
30.30 Draw, drains SE. about 5 chs. then S.

33.33 Intersect the E. Bdy. of T. 44 N., R. 24 E., at a point, N. 0° 14' W., 14.54 chs. distant from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2. At the point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing corner for the NW. Cor. of T. 44 N., R. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of the cor., also deposit a basalt stone 12x8x4 ins. marked with a cross (x) on one face at base of post.
Land: slightly rolling mesa.
Soil: heavy clay containing many rock.
Undergrowth: sage. Fair growth of grass.

SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF FRACTIONAL T.44 N., R.24 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. Bdy. of the township, which is an iron post, 2 ins. in diam., firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as described in the field notes of T. 43 N., R. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$
