Chains

West, on a true line, on the N. Bdy. of sec. 6.

Along gentle W. slope over high and slightly rolling mesa.

2.30 Road, bears N. and S.

14.00 Cross head of large draw, drains N., thence along N. slope.

24.00 Thence across flat mesa.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins.

in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6, only, with brass cap mkd.
