

Survey of the W. Bdy. of T. 44 N., R. 25 E.

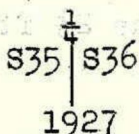
Chains. Land: rolling mountainous.
 Soil: heavy clay, very rocky.
 Undergrowth: sage. Good growth of grass.

Survey of the subdivisions of T. 44 N., R. 25 E.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. Bdy.
 of the township, which is an iron post 2 ins. in diam.,
 firmly set and properly marked and witnessed, as
 described in the field notes of T. 43 N., R. 25 E.,
 N. 0° 01' W. bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Desc. gradually over slightly rolling mesa.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 28 ins.
 in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, W.
 of the cor.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 16 ins.
 in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone,
 4 ft. base, 20 ins. high, for the cor. of secs. 25,
 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.



At base of post deposit a volcanic stone, 12 x 6 x 6
 ins. marked with cross (x).

Land: high, slightly rolling mesa.
 Soil: very rocky and heavy clay strewn with surface
 rock of volcanic origin.
 Undergrowth: sage. Fair growth of grass.
