80.00	<p>The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, which is an iron post, 9 ins. above the ground, 2 ins. in diam., properly marked and witnessed as described in the official record of T. 25 N., R. 67 E., Nevada. Hereafter this corner will refer to secs. 31 and 32, only. I obliterate all marks pertaining to secs. 5 and 6. I also destroy the mound of stone to the west and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of the post.</p> <p>Land, rough mountainous; general drainage NE. and SW.
