Chains N. 89° 58' E., on a true line, bet. secs. 6 and 31.  
Over rolling land, thru medium undergrowth. Desc. 30 ft.  
over a NW. slope.

13.10 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course S. 70° W.; asc.  
50 ft. over the right rim of wash.

15.65 Road, bears NE. and SW.
