	Raise a mound of stone West of corner.
	Land; rolling to broken mountainous.
	Soil, shallow sandy to gravelly loam, with coarse sub-soil, 3rd. and 4th rate.
	Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, service berry and willow along bottom of draw.
	No timber.
DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONS OF T. 20 N., R. 19 E.	
	From the corner of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on the S.Bdy. of the Twp., previously described.
	N. 0° 24' E., on a true line, between secs. 31 and 32.
	Over rolling and broken SE. slopes through very dense large undergrowth. Ascend gradually.
4.80	Small draw, drains SE.
13.40	Spur, 90 ft. above cor., projects S. 75° E., descend 50 ft. over broken NE. slope.
23.50	Bottom of large shallow draw, drains S. 70° E.
24.78	Intersect line 3-4 of the "Ferndale Lode" Mineral Segregation Survey N. 61° 07' W., 3.06 chs. distant from cor. No. 4.
	Leave bottom of draw and ascend gravelly S. slope.
35.40	Slope changes to gradual SW.
40.55	At proportionate point, on gravelly SW. slope, 180 ft. above draw.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground for the restored $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, with brass cap marked
