

Retracement of the State Boundary line between Mile Posts 155 and 157 along the West Boundary of Secs. 30 and 31, T. 22 N., R. 18 East.

Chains Raise a mound of stone 3x3x1 ft. high around post.  
U.S.M.M.No. 1 bears N. 74° 07' E. 21.86 chains.  
Cor. No. 1 Lot.No. 45, Homestake lode bears N. 23° 04' E.  
4.52 chs.

Thence

S. 0° 15' W., on true course, bet. 156 and 157 Mile Post corners.

68.03 A point on true line projected through the old closing corner of Secs. 6 and 31 bears N. 89° 57' E., 58 lks. distant and the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.

Establish corner at this point as hereinafter described.

72.32 Intersect a point 12 lks. W. of the old closing corner of secs. 6 and 31, T. 21 and 22 N., R. 18 E., M.D.M., California, which is a granite stone 6x8x22 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, marked with 6 notches on S. face.

79.42 Intersect the 157 Mile Post corner, which is a surfaced 4x4 in. post, 4 ft. high, firmly set in a mound of stone, at south base of small outcrop on west edge of top of rocky spur projecting S. from N. This corner is plainly scribed and being in an excellent state of preservation, is not replaced by an iron post.

RESURVEY OF THE SOUTH, EAST AND NORTH BOUNDARIES OF SEC.  
31 T. 22 N., R. 18 E. M.D.M.

The original corner of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on the S. bdy. of the Twp., is a granite stone, 10x18x20 ins., marked 5 notches on NE. corner, firmly set in a mound of stone on E. slope.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to solid rock and 2 ft. in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, with brass cap mkd
