Resurvey of the South, East and North Boundaries of Sec. 31 T.22NR18E.

Chains Deposit a rock, 4x6x10 ins. marked cross (x) on top, at base of mound alongside iron post.

Thence
S. 89° 57' W., on true line, between secs. 6 and 31.
Ascend E. slope through very dense undergrowth over broken mountainous slopes.

7.50 Spur ridge, 130 ft. above sec. cor., projects S. 10°W. from N. 10° E. descend 250 ft. over broken SW. and W. slopes to corner.

20.03 Intersect the old closing corner of secs. 6 and 31, which is a granite stone, 2x10x18 ins. faintly marked CC on E. face, securely set in an old mound of stones on rocky E. slope. I add the marks "W P" to this corner and reset stone firmly in center of old mound of stone.

20.61 Intersect Nevada-California State Boundary line, N. 0° 15' E., 11.39 chs. distant from the 157 Mile Post corner hereinbefore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and 20 ins. in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd

Deposit a rock, 6x7x8 ins., marked cross (x) at base of mound alongside post.

Land, broken Mountainous.

Soil, shallow gravelly and rocky loam, clay subsoil, 3rd. rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush. No timber.
