

Resurvey of the South, East and North Boundaries of Sec. 31, T22N. R. 18E.


Chains Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush.  
 No timber.

From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32  
 N. 88° 35' W. on true line, between secs. 30 and 31.  
 Descend abrupt W. slope, 420 ft. to cor.

19.84 Intersect the original closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31,  
 which is a granite stone, 8x10x14 ins., marked 5 grooves  
 N. and 1 S., firmly set in an old mound of stone,  
 I mark "WP" on E. face of stone.

20.26 Intersect the Nevada-California State line, N. 0° 02' E.,  
 11.25 chs. distant from the 156 Mile Post hereinbefore  
 described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in  
 the ground, for the closing corner of secs. 30 and 31,  
 with brass cap mkd.




Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.

SEGREGATION SURVEY OF THE TRI-METALLIC LODE

Identical with the NW. location corner of the Tri-Metallic  
 Lode which is a 4x4 in. surface post, 3 ft. long  
 and firmly set in a mound of stone. On South end line  
 3-4 of Survey No. 45, Homestake Lode at N. 48° 28' E.  
 1.54 chs. from Cor. No. 3 of said Homestake Lode.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in  
 the ground, for Cor. No. 4 of the Tri-Metallic Lode  
 with brass cap mkd.
