Chains.

Alongside the old cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, which is a mound of stone, with no evidence of markings, identified as the old original cor. by Chas. Kolback, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 32 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, with brass cap mkd.

Alongside, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 32 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd.
