and S. center line, to intersection with the meander line of Pyramid Lake.

A traverse line along east side of the right-of-way of the highway through lot 3, sec. 15, was run and monumented as hereinafter described in these notes.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 10 and 15, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., extending 10 ins. above the ground, with brass cap marked

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Witnessed by a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high to the N.

Thence

N. $89^{\circ} 47'E.$, bet. secs. 10 and 15 on retracement.

14.80 Fall 3 lks. N. of meander cor., bet. frac. secs. 10 and 15, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., extending 10 ins. above the ground, with brass cap properly marked and witnessed as described in the original record.

The course of this line therefore is N. $89^{\circ} 54'E.$, and the distance is 14.80 chs.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 15 and 22, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., extending 10 ins. above the ground, with brass cap properly marked and witnessed as described in the original record, thence N. $89^{\circ} 47'E.$, bet. secs. 15 and 22, on retracement.

37.36 Intersect the meander cor. of frac. secs. 15 and 22, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., extending 10 ins. above the ground, with brass cap properly marked and witnessed as described in original records.
