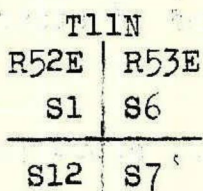


SURVEY OF EAST BOUNDARY T. 11 N., R. 52 E.

Chains



Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling bench.

Soil, sandy gravelly loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, none.

Undergrowth, medium sagebrush, yellow brush, black sage, scattering white sage.

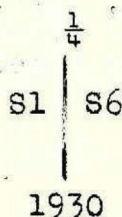
General drainage, E. Grazing, fair.

North between secs. 1 and 6

Over rolling bench land

Along general E. slope

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

80.05 At a point directly east of the northwest corner of T. 11 N., R. 52 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of Ts. 11 and 12 N., Rs. 52 and 53 E., with brass cap mkd
