

Mineral Segregation Survey in T. 33 N., R. 37 E.

Subdivision of Section 17.

Chains

N 52°58' E of corner No. 1.

36.03 Intersect line 1-4, of the Gold Standard lode, 2.49 chains S 37°02' E of corner No. 1.

40.05 True point for the center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 17.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in dia. 26 ins. in the ground and in a small mound of stone for the center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 17, with a brass cap marked:

From which,

A cross (X) on a Rhyolite outcrop, approximately 4 ft high and 8 ft. square, bears S 50°20' E, 70 lks. dist. Outcrop marked:

Continue S 0°09' W, on true centerline, without chaining, and intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 20, which is an iron post, 1 in. in dia., properly marked and set and witnessed as described in the notes of the resurvey of T. 33 N., R. 37 E., Group 119 Nevada.

Survey of the Vindicator No. 1 Lode.

Beginning at the cor. No. 1 of the Vindicator No. 1 Lode, which is an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in dia., set 27 ins. in the ground, with a brass cap marked:

From which,

A juniper, 8 ins. in dia. bears S 9°30' W, 08.8 lks. dist., marked: VINDICATOR 1 COR 1 BT.

A juniper, 3 ins. in dia., bears N 42°30' W, 32.7 lks. dist., marked: 'BT' only.

From the cor. point, the location corner bears S 18°24' W, 4.818 chains distant, also,
