

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTION OF 4TH STAN. PAR. NORTH  
S. BDY. T. 21 N., R. 53 E.

Chains	Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy and gravelly loam, 2nd rate. Timber, none. Undergrowth, white sage, sagebrush. General drainage, NE. Grazing, poor.
	West, along S. bdy. sec. 32.
	Over gently rolling land through dense undergrowth,
5.30	Road, bears N. and S. 5° W.
6.30	Unused road, bears N. 15° E. and S. 10° W.
30.31	At mid-point bet. the closing cors. of secs. 4 and 5, and secs. 5 and 6.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a glass bottle deposited at the base, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 5, with brass cap mkd.
	$\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 1933 dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a glass bottle deposited at the base, for the stan. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
	SC $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 1933 dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist.
	The original stan. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., bears S. 46° 11' W., 2.00 chs., and is an earth mound with traces of old pits. I destroy all traces of same.
70.84	The closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, which is described in Book "A" of field notes under this group.
80.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a glass bottle deposited at the base, for the stan. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd.
	SC T21NR53E S31   S32 1933 dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., one in each section, 3 ft. dist.
	The original stan. sec. cor., bears S. 45° 16' W., 2.07 chs., and is a partially decayed cedar post lying on top of faint trace of earth mound, markings illegible. I destroy all traces of same.
	Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy clay loam with gravel surfaces, 2nd rate. Timber, none. Undergrowth, sagebrush, rabbit brush. General drainage, NW. Grazing, poor.
	West, along S. bdy. sec. 31.
	Over gently rolling land through dense undergrowth.
