Chains. Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of the cor.  
 Land: slightly rolling mesa.  
 Soil: heavy clay strewn with much surface rock of volcanic origin.  
 Undergrowth: sage. Fair growth of grass.

North on the E. Bdy. of sec. 1.  
 Desc. gradually over slightly rolling mesa.

- 15.00 Shallow wash, drains NE. Asc. gradually.
- 30.00 Desc. gradual N. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, with brass cap mkd.
