25.50 Dry wash in Alameda canyon, drains E. Asc. 290 ft.
35.70 A northing of 40.00 chs. from the cor. of secs. 6 and 7. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6 only, with brass cap mkd.
