

Survey of the N. Bdy. of T. 21 N., R. 34 E.

Chains. At base of post deposit a limestone 14 x 10 x 6 ins. marked with cross (x).

Land: E. 25.00 chs. slightly rolling; W. 48.00 chs. broken and mountainous.

Soil: gravelly and rocky clay of medium texture.

Undergrowth: sage and shadscale. Scattered growth of grass.

Very scattering pinon pine and juniper on W. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.

From the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36 on the S. Bdy. of the township,
