

Establishment of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. and sec. corners for
T. 32 N., R. 59 E., on portion of N. bdy. of T. 31 N., R. 59 E.

Chains

A cross (X) on granite boulder showing 6 ft. diam., by 2 ft. above ground, marked BO X S31, bears N. $61\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 88 lks. dist. No other accessories available.

West, on S. bdy. sec. 31.

- 0.94 The original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in ground and supported by a large mound of stone, properly marked and witnessed as described in official records of T. 31 N., R. 59 E. I efface the marks on post, bearing tree and bearing object pertaining to T. 32 N., R. 59 E., leaving same for cor. of secs. 5 and 6, T. 31 N. R. 59 E., only.
- 40.00 The true point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 32 N., R. 59 E., falls on steep E. slope in sliderock at base of cliff to W., where corner cannot be perpetuated. No cor. set here.
- 40.94 The true point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 31 N., R. 59 E.
- 42.94 The original witness cor. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, an iron post, 1 in. dia., firmly set in ground and supported by a mound of stone, properly marked, and witnessed by two bearing objects as described in official records of T. 31 N., R. 59 E. This witness cor. now becomes the witness cor. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 32 N., R. 59 E., being W. 21.94 chs. from true cor. point, and the witness cor. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 31 N., R. 59 E., being W. 2.00 chs. from true cor. point.
- 80.94 The original cor. of Ts. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E. This cor. was later changed to refer to T. 31 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E. only. See notes of T. 32 N., R. 58 E. of this group.
- 111.76 The cor. of T. 32 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E. established in survey of E. bdy. T. 32 N., R. 58 E. under this Group.
