

EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 32 N., R. 58 E.

Chains

Commence at the cor. of secs. 18 and 19 on W. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 59 E., established by Haigh and Clark, U.S. Surveyors in 1916, under Group No. 29, and which is South, 16.90 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, on E. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 58 E.

Thence

South, on a random line for distance only, along E. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 58 E.; and W. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 59 E., and at 239.25 chs. intersect a point West, 30.82 chs. dist. from the cor. of Ts. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E. At point of intersection the cor. of T. 32 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E. is established, see true line for description.

Corners for R. 58 E. are established at regular intervals of 40.00 chs. from the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, placing the fractional measurement against the south boundary; and corners for R. 59 E. are established at regular intervals of 40.00 chs. counting from the SW. cor. of T. 32 N., R. 59 E., placing fractional measurement against the cor. of secs. 18 and 19.

Thence from the cor. of secs. 18 and 19 on W. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 59 E., which is an iron post, 2 ins. dia., firmly set in a mound of stone, properly marked as described in official records and witnessed by a mound of stone, E. of cor. This cor. is situated on steep, rocky S. slope below high, broken cliffs.

South, on true line along E. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 58 E., on E. bdy. of sec. 24, counting distances from the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, which is North, 16.90 chs. dist.

Desc. steep, mountainous slope, through medium mahogany timber and medium undergrowth.
