A limber pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N. $78\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 10.87 chs. dist., marked T32N R58E S36 BT

And raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor. Corner set in Lamoille Canyon, 7.10 chs. W. of Lamoille Creek, draining N. 20° E. from SW.

High point on divide of mountain, bears N. $49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles distant; N. face of high cliff on divide, bears S. $58^{\circ}55'$ E., about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile dist.; rocky peak at head of Lamoille Canyon, bears S. 45° W., about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles dist.; and Lamoille Lake, bears approximately S. 30° W., 1 mile dist.

Land, high, rough mountainous with E. exposure and drainage into Lamoille Canyon.

Soil, rocky of granite formation in form of bedrock, outcrops and ledges, and shallow mountain loam; 4th rate.

Timber, scattered limber pine and few aspen.

Undergrowth, scattered sagebrush, oak and service brush.

Fair grazing land.

SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T. 32 N., R. 58 E.

From the cor. of T. 32 N., Rs. 58 and 59 E.

West, on random line along S. bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 58 E.,

setting temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. and sec. cors. at intervals of 40.00 chs., and at 479.65 chs., intersect E. bdy. of T. 31 N., R. 57 E., South, 12.98 chs. dist. from the cor. of Ts. 31 and 32 N., Rs. 57 and 58 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. dia., extending 12 ins. above
