	<p>S. <math>0^{\circ}07'</math> W., on 163rd mile.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p>
15.50	Old road, bears N. $80^{\circ}$ W. and S. $80^{\circ}$ E.
58.70	Old road, bears N. $25^{\circ}$ E. and S. $25^{\circ}$ W.
79.89	<p>Proportionate point,</p> <p>Set a granite stone, 6x10x16 ins., (no iron post available) 12 ins. in the ground, for restored 163rd mile cor., marked N on W., U 163 on E., and a cross (X) on N. face; also set a pinon post, 4 ins. diam., 3 ft. long, 24 ins. in the ground alongside stone, and deposit glass at base of stone. Raise a mound of earth around cor.</p> <p>Land, nearly level; exposure N. to NE.</p> <p>Soil, gravelly clay loam; 2nd rate.</p> <p>Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood and few sagebrush.</p>
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	<p>S. <math>0^{\circ}07'</math> W. on the 164th mile.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p>
17.10	Shallow swale, drains NE.
79.89	<p>Intersect the 164th mile cor., which is pinon post, 5 ins. squared, 6 ft. long, loosely set in ground, marked UTAH on E., NEV on W., and 164 on S. face; reset post at same point, 2 ft. in ground; deposit glass, and a granite stone, 10x8x3 ins., marked with a cross (X), at base of post; and raise a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 6 ft. base, around post.</p> <p>Land, nearly level; slight NE. exposure.</p> <p>Soil, gravelly and sandy clay; 1st and 2nd rates.</p> <p>Undergrowth, shadscale and greasewood.</p>
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	<p>S. <math>0^{\circ}24'</math> W., on the 165th mile.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p>
20.80	Dim trace of old road, bears E. and W.
