


Dependent Resurvey of East Boundary, T.13 N., R.70 E.

Chains

of the original cor. monument which was then in place, but has since disappeared. In place of the cedar post, Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 30 ins. in the ground, for reestablished cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap marked



Deposit glass at base of post.

Other accessories impracticable.

Center of Sylvester Tweedy's house bears S.27°20'E., about 9 chs. dist.

S. 72°15'E.; 46 lks. dist. to cor. of fences from E., W., and S.

Land, nearly level with slight E. exposure and drainage. Soil, fine clay and sandy clay loams; 1st rate.


Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood and rabbit brush.

N. 0°17' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over nearly level land through medium undergrowth.

40.06½ Proportionate point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for restored ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.; and deposit glass around post.

58.20 Old road, bears NE. and SW.

62.20 Dry wash, 5 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains E.

74.00 Road, bears N.20°W. and S.20°E.

80.13 Intersect the original cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 N., Rs. 70 and 71 E., which is center of distinct trace of old
