

Survey of Tract No. 37, T. 11 ^N S., Rs. 48 & 49 E.

Chains

The survey of tract No. 37 located in portions of unsurveyed secs. 36 and 31, T. 11 N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., Mt. Diablo Mer., conforms with listing survey made by the Forest Service of Indian Allotment for Wagon Johnnie.

I commence at corner No. 1 of the listing survey made by the Forest Service, which is a porphyry stone, showing 16x18x10 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked with a cross on top and H 1 on S. face, from which a rock in place, marked W H 1, bears S.72°E., 31 lks. dist.; and a rock in place, showing 3½x1½x1 ft., marked W H 1, bears N.76½°W., 35 lks. dist.

Remove rock cor. and at same point set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia., 12 ins. in the ground to underlying rock, and supported by a large mound of stone, for angle point No. 1 of tract No. 37, with brass cap marked

Destroy the marks on rock cor.

From this angle point the standard cor. of T. 11 N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., hereinafter described, bears S.64°22½'W. 22.06 chs.

Thence

S. 88°10' W., on true line bet. angle points Nos. 1 and 2.

Along a general S. slope over rolling land on N. side of Green Monster Creek, through medium dense cedar and pinon timber.

7.40 Point from which Wagon Johnnies' house, bears about south of line, 60 lks. distant.

7.80 Wire fence along N. side of claim, bears nearly E. and W. thence along N. edge of canyon bottom, bearing N.80°W. and S.80°E.

9.25 Recross same fence, bears N.30°E. for about 25 lks. dist. to cor. thence E.; and S.30°W. for about 1 ch. to E.
