- Chains Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.
- 45.60 Small spring, bears S. $1\frac{1}{2}$ chs.
- 51.60 Draw, drains SE. about 10 chs., thence E.
Abrupt ascent of E. slope 590 ft. to closing cor.
- 51.70 Spring, bears S. 5 chs.
