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The original cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 S., Rs. 57 and 58 E., is a limestone, 22x16x14 ins. set in an old, deeply embedded mound of stone, dimly marked with 6 notches on N., S., E., and W. edges. Alongside cor., Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 20 ins. in the ground on solid rock and in a mound of stone, with brass cap marked
