

DEPENDENT RESURVEY EAST BOUNDARY OF T.19 S., R.56 E.

Chains	Description
0.00	No series is to east of spur. No signs of abnata. On A limber pine, 16 ins. diam., bears N.47 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., 69 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 56 E S 35 B T
1.00	On west side of spur, just above .ft 004, find sign of abnata. A limber pine, 22 ins. diam., bears N.55°W., 93 lks. dist., marked T 19 S R 56 E S 34 B T
2.00	Land, rough, rugged mountains; general N. and SW. exposure and drainage from divide or summit of the Charleston Mountains.
2.40	Soil, gravelly and rocky of limestone formation; 4th. rate.
3.00	Timber, limber pine, fir, mahogany, and scattered aspen and yellow pine.
3.50	Undergrowth, choke cherry and young timber.
4.00	Dependent Resurvey East Boundary of T.19 S., R.56 E.
4.50	From the reestablished cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 S., Rs. 56 and 57 E.,
5.00	N.1°13'E., bet. secs. 31 and 36.
5.50	Along steep W. slope over rugged mountainous land through medium growth of yellow pine, balsam fir and mahogany timber and medium dense undergrowth.
6.75	Rocky point, projects W.; descend abruptly.
10.00	Depression on W. slope of spur, 210 ft. below point, T 8 S drains W.; gradually ascend.
16.35	Spur, 20 ft. above depression, projects N.10°W. from T 8 S S.10°E.; descend along E. slope.
22.40	Balsam fir tree, 42 ins. in diameter on line; I blaze tree with two notches on N. and S. sides for line tree.
25.90	Recross same spur, forks by N.E. and N.30°W.; begin abrupt descent over N. slope.
26.00	Leave timber, bears NE. and NW.
31.00	Reenter medium growth of timber, bears E. and W.
32.70	Draw, 200 ft. below forks of spur, drains NE.; scattered aspen timber in bottom of draw. Descend along E. slope.
