

RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 19 S., R. 56 E.

Chains
55.10

Small draw, drains E.

59.00

Main draw, drains SE. from N. 10° W.; asc. 248 ft. over a steep S. slope to 64.89 ch. point.

63.80

Slope changes to W.

64.89

Intersect the N. bdy. of the township.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.

A yellow pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 35¼° E., 128 lks. dist., mkd. T19SR56ES2CCBT.

A yellow pine, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 239 lks. dist., mkd. T19SR56ES3CCBT.

Cor. stands on steep W. slope.

From the point of intersection, the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 34, T. 19 S., R. 56 E., heretofore described, bears N. 84°13' W., 15.03 chs. dist.

From the same point, the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., heretofore described, bears S. 84°13' E., 27.105 chs. dist.

Land, rough mountainous, except in extreme southern part. Soil, rich mountainous loam in main canyon bottom; shallow loam on hillsides and draw bottoms; 1st and 3rd rates.

Timber, yellow pine, limber pine, mahogany pinon. Undergrowth, wild currant bushes and young timber.

From the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in Book "A" of this group.


West, on a temp. line bet. secs. 27 and 34.

Set temp. point.

Set temp. ¼ sec. cor. at base of high cliffs, which are impossible to chain; therefore, I return to the temp. point at 24.30 and set flag "A", thence on top of main divide ridge of Spring Mt.; set flag "B" West on line; from flag "B" measure a base line 15.175 chs. to flag "C". By three repetitions of each angle:



At flag "A" 23°00'30"

At flag "B" 56°35'

At flag "C" 100°24'30"

Distance by triangulation 38.19 chs.

Distance by chaining 24.30 chs.

62.49 chs.
