Chains	
52.30	Top of main divide ridge, 298 ft. above the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., bears N. 75° E. and N. 63° W.; desc. over heavily timbered N. slope 585 ft. to 73.07 ch. point.
54.00	Small draw, heads 50 lks. E. of line and drains N.
64.30	Ravine, heading at 54.00 ch. point, drains N. 5° W.
72.70	Same ravine, drains N. 5° E.
73.07	Intersect the N. bdy. of the township, Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap mkd.

	A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $58\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 80 lks. dist., mkd. T19SR56ES3CCBT.
	A cattail pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 77° W., 79 lks. dist., mkd. T19SR56ES4CCBT.
	Cor. stands on W. side of ravine.
	From the point of intersection, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 33, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., heretofore described, bears N. $84^{\circ}13'$ W., 18.82 chs. dist.
	From the same point, the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., heretofore described, bears S. $84^{\circ}13'$ E., 23.315 chs. dist.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky loam; 3rd rate. Timber, cattail pine, yellow pine, fir and aspen. Undergrowth, mountain shrubs. Native grass.
	Thence, from the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34 West, on a temp. line, bet. secs. 28 and 33.

80.00	Set temp. cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33.

	S. $0^{\circ}02'$ E., on a random line bet. secs. 32 and 33.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
69.96	Intersect the S. bdy. of the township, 22 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 on the S. bdy., heretofore described.
