RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 19 S., R. 56 E.

Chains

from which

A yellow pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 74 1/4° W., 201 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S6BT.
A yellow pine, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 50°45' E., 151 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S7BT.

The original 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, bears N. 73°54' E., 5.165 chs. dist., hereinafter described.

Desc. 172 ft. to 68.39 ch. point.

41.70 Large draw, drains from N. and joins main canyon, which drains N. 85° W.; continue along S. slope of canyon.

53.10 N. edge of bottom of canyon, bears S. 80° E. and N. 85° W. desc. along bottom of canyon, through medium dense timber.

56.60 Wash, in bottom of canyon, 10 lks. wide and 2 ft. deep, drains W.

59.70 Road, bears S. 80° E. and S. 80° W.

66.70 Road, in bottom of wash, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.

68.39 Intersect the W. bdy. of the township.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, and in a large mound of stone to top of post, for the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.

A yellow pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 70 1/4° E., 22 lks. dist., mkd. T19SR56ES6CCBT.
A yellow pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 17 1/4° E., 23 lks. dist., mkd. T19SR56ES7CCBT.

From point of intersection, the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, T. 19 S., R. 55 E., heretofore described, bears N. 0°11' E., 169.75 chs. dist.

From the same point the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 12, heretofore described, bears S. 0°11' W., 22.57 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky loam; 4th rate.
Timber, yellow pine and fir.
Undergrowth, wild currant bushes and young timber.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

N. 0°03' W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through medium dense timber and undergrowth; across bottom of canyon.

.05 Road, bears S.80°W. & N.80° E., 3 chs. to end.
