## Chains

Control for the location of this entry is taken from the original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8, and the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7. Where these points do not furnish sufficient control, the bdrs. are conformed to record courses and distances, with the exception of the W. bdy., which is conformed to the reestablished W. bdy. of the township bet. the intersections of the N. and S. bdrs.

Beginning at the NE. cor. of the claim, which is midpoint in distance bet. the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  and sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for angle point 1/42, with brass cap mkd.
