## Chains

S. 88° 31' W., bet. secs. 6. and 31.

Over rough mountainous land, through dense timber and scattering undergrowth; desc. 700 ft. over a steep W. slope.

18.40 Draw, drains N. 10° W.; asc. 31 ft. along a NE. slope.

22.70 Spur, projects N. 10° W.; desc. 70 ft. over a W. slope.

26.35 Draw, drains N.; asc. an E. slope 45 ft.

29.60 Spur, projects N.; desc. a W. slope 85 ft.

33.35 Draw, drains N. 10° E.; asc. 28 ft. along a NE. slope.

39.39 Proportionate point for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.,Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone to top, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Continue ascent over steep NE. slope 555 ft.

50.70 Draw, drains N. 20° E. for which course was run.

55.00 Ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. a W. slope 175 ft.

77.23 The reestablished cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 S., Rs. 56 and 57 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in Book "A" of this group.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 4th rate.

Undergrowth, chaparral and mountain rush.

Timber, yellow pine, fir, aspen.
