Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky; 4th rate.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush and cacti.
Pinon and juniper.

N. 05° 50' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through scattering undergrowth and timber; asc. 160 ft. along an E. to SE. slope.

41.00 Main divide ridge, bears NW. and S. 75° E.; desc. 855 ft. to the 83.92 ch. point.

41.96 Proportionate point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

52.00 Spur, projects N. 20° W., continue descent over a NE. slope.

83.92 The original cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 S., Rs. 57 and 58 E., which is a limestone, 14x12x8 ins., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. 6 grooves on all four edges.

At cor. point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 S., Rs. 57 and 58 E., with brass cap mkd.
