

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE N. BDY. OF T. 19 S., R. 56 E.

Chains

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34 only, with brass cap mkd.

A yellow pine, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 75° E., 117 lks. dist., mkd. S34BT.

A yellow pine, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 27° W., 29 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S34BT.

Desc. over a SE. slope 172 ft.

53.50 Small wash, drains SE.; asc. 35 ft. over a W. slope through very dense timber.

58.60 Continue along broken N. slope of crest of a spur projecting E.; desc. 290 ft.

84.27 Original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, Tps. 18 and 19 S., Rs. 56 E., which is a pine stake, 24 ins. above ground, 4x4 ins. sq., firmly set in a small mound of stone, and bearing faint but indistinct scribe marks.

At point for cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground with original corner stake deposited at the base, for cor. of secs. 34 and 35 only, with brass cap mkd.

A balsam, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 35° E., 106 lks. dist., mkd. T18SR56ES35BT.

A balsam, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 19 lks. dist., mkd. TXVIIISRLVIESXXXVBT. (Original bearing tree.)

A yellow pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 33 lks. dist., mkd. TXVIIISRLVIESXXXIVBT. (Original bearing tree.)

Land, rough mountainous.

Soil, rocky; 4th rate.

Undergrowth, mountain shrubs.

Timber, cattail pine, yellow pine, and balsam pine.

N. 89°25' E., along the S. bdy. of sec. 35, T. 18 S., R. 56 E.

Over mountainous land, through medium dense timber and undergrowth; asc. 53 ft.

2.50 Spur projects NE.; desc. abrupt E. slope 242 ft.
