State Selection, List No. 6, embracing lots 1 and 2,  
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 1, together with the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of  
sec. 12, and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 13, approved  
August 12, 1907; 789.87 acres.

The east and north boundaries of this tract are made  
conformable with the reestablished east and north bdys.  
of the township; the remaining tract boundaries are made  
to conform to the theoretical position of a strictly de-  
pendent resurvey of the sections, or portions of sections,  
involved; namely, Secs. 1, 12 and 13.

Beginning at AP 1 of Tract 37, which is identical with  
the cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 S., Rs. 56 and 57 E., an iron  
post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as  
described in the official record.

Thence

S.  $80^{\circ}56'$  W., along the N. bdy., bet. secs. 1 and 36,35.49 AP 2 of Tract 37, which is identical with the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
of sec. 36, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., heretofore described.

Thence

S.  $5^{\circ}25'$  W., along the W. bdy., bet. public land in Sec.  
1 and Tract No. 37,74.37 Intersect the line bet. secs. 1 and 12 at a point from  
which the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12 bears N.  $89^{\circ}41'$   
W., 8.37 chs. distant.Thence, with continuous line and measurement, bet. public  
land in Sec. 12 and Tract No. 37.79.03 Point for AP 3 of Tract No. 37, identical with the com-  
puted position for the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1  
and 12.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in  
the ground to solid rock, and in a supporting mound of  
stone 3 ft. base to top of post, for angle point 3/37,  
with brass cap mkd.
