


N.  $1^\circ 13'$  E., along the E. bdy. of the tract, which conforms to the east boundary of the township.

- 19.14 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for angle points 10/37 and 3/56, with brass cap mkd.



- A balsam fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.  $75\frac{3}{4}^\circ$  W., 5 lks. dist. mkd. TR 37 AP 10 BT.

N.  $3^\circ 18'$  E., bet. Tracts Nos. 37 and 56,

- 19.87 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 22 ins. in the ground and in a small supporting mound of stones, for angle points 11/37 and 2/56, with brass cap mkd.
