


METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY OF PRIVATE CLAIMS IN T. 19 S., R. 56 E.

Chains

20.00 At a point which is 80.00 chs. South of the original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for angle points 6/40 and 2/44, with brass cap mkd.



Thence

East, along S. bdy., bet. Tracts 40 and 44.

18.96 Angle points 7/40 and 3/39, heretofore described.

Thence

North, along E. bdy., bet. Tracts 39 and 40.

60.12 Angle point 8/40 and 2/39, heretofore described.

Thence

N. 89° 25' E., along S. bdy., bet. Tracts 39 and 40.

18.96 Angle points 9/40 and 1/39, heretofore described.

Thence

N. 0° 16' W., along E. bdy., bet. Tracts 38 and 40.

19.83 The original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35 and angle point 1/40, the place of beginning, heretofore described.

Tract 41

State Selection, List No. 11, embracing the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 5, approved Nov. 10, 1888; List No. 13, embracing the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 5, approved July 3, 1891; total, 80 acres.

Control for the location of this entry is taken from the original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8; the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8; the original cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9; and the reestablished positions for the original cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33 and secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on the N. bdy. of the Tp. The S. bdy. of the tract is identical with the original west half mile bet. secs. 5 and 8; the E., N., and W. bdrs. of the tract are made conformable to the appropriate subdivision-of-section lines of Sec. 5 in their original position.

Beginning at the NE. cor. of the tract,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for angle point 1/41, with brass cap mkd.
