

## METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY OF PRIVATE CLAIMS IN T. 19 S., R. 56 E.

Tract 43

State Selection, List # 6, embracing the  $S\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 3; all of sec. 10; the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$ , the  $N\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$ , and the  $SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 9; the  $N\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 15; the  $NE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$ , and the  $S\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 16; approved August 12, 1907.

Control for the location of this entry is taken from the original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 on the N. bdy. of the Tp. The NE. cor. of the claim is fixed at record distance from this original cor. and all bdrs. are surveyed on cardinal course with distances at full 20 chain units.
