METES AND BOUNDS SURVEY OF PRIVATE CLAIMS T. 19 S., R. 56 E.

Chains

19.87 Angle point 3/56 and 10/37, heretofore described.

Thence

N. 82°27' E. bet. tracts 56 and 37.

19.14 The restored 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, heretofore described, which is also angle point 4/56 and 9/37.

Thence

N. 1°13' E., along the E. bdy. of the township.

19.96 Angle point 1/56 and 12/37, the place of beginning.

Tract 57

Public land, embracing the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of sec. 9 of the original survey, 40 acres. This parcel of land is entirely surrounded by private land, and for the purpose of affording a better basis of description and disposal, is assigned a tract number and monumented as such.

Control for the location of this entry is taken from angle point 6 of tract 43, heretofore described. This angle point is the SW. cor. of the claim. The bdrs. are run at cardinal courses and record distances from this point.
