

RETRACEMENT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF CORNERS
ON THE EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL NORTH THROUGH R. 21 E.

Chains

Land, E. $\frac{1}{4}$ mile; rolling and hilly; balance of mile nearly level bottom land.
Soil, gravelly and coarse, 3rd rate on slopes; medium fine, silt-like surface soil over gravelly subsoil, 2nd rate on bottom lands.
Undergrowth, sagebrush, yellowtop, shadscale, greasewood.
Timber, a very few isolated junipers and pinons north of line.

S. $88^{\circ}56'W.$, along the S. bdy. of sec. 31,

Over nearly level land thru medium dense large sagebrush undergrowth.

.74 A basalt rock, 16x6x12 ins., mkd. " $\frac{1}{4}$ WC" on E. face; no additional markings and the identity of this monument could not be determined. It is of recent origin and does not belong to any of the official survey systems.

16.75 Dry channel, 5 ft. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S.

17.59 A basalt rock, 7x9x10 ins., mkd with 6 grooves on E. and W. faces and "WC" on S. face. This cor. is unofficial and does not belong to any of the official survey systems.

31.69 The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31 as reestablished under Gr. 48 Nevada, which is a 1 in. iron post, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
I destroy this corner.

40.01 At a westing of 40.00 chs.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a basalt rock, 16x6x6 ins., mkd. cross (x) at base of post.

44.71 Dry flood-channel, 6 ft. wide, 3 ft. deep, course N. 10° E.

61.51 The closing cor. of Tps. 40 N., Rs. 20 and 21 E., which is a 3 in. iron post, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

65.90 Dry channel, 4 ft. wide, 2 ft. deep, course N. 10° E.

70.91 The standard cor. of Tps. 41 N., Rs. 20 and 21 E., which is a 3 in. iron post set alongside the original corner stone, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land, level.

Soil, fine texture, clay loam, varying in depth from 4 ins. to more than 36 ins., 2nd rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, yellowtop, shadscale.

No timber.
