Chains

ground to solid rock with a basalt rock, 9x3x2 ins., mkd. cross (x) deposited at base and supported in a large mound of stone, for the cor. of secs. 31 and 32 only, with brass cap mkd.

 Soil, sandy to gravelly loam, 2nd rate.

 S. 88° 21' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 31,  
 Over rolling land thru dense small undergrowth.  
 Desc. gradual W. slope, 250 ft. to  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

47.43 Proportionate point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 31 only, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Continue over gentle sloping N. and NW. slopes, of rolling bench lands.

61.40 Rocky rim, 20 ft. high, facing W., at W. edge of bench lands, bears N. and S. 20° E., desc. 130 ft. over abrupt rocky W. slope.

69.00 Base of steep W. slope, bears N. and S., continue over nearly level land thru very dense sagebrush undergrowth.

88.00 Old road, bears NE. and S. 30° W.

94.10 The cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N., Rs. 20 and 21 E., which is marked by the decayed stub of a pine stake in the center of an old mound of earth. Faint traces of pits are seen to the NE. and SE. of the corner point.

At corner point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground with old stake alongside, for the cor. of Tps. 41 and 42 N., Rs. 20 and 21 E., with brass cap mkd.
