

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY OF T. 41 N., R. 21 E.

Chains

N. 0°45' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 12 with continuous measurement.

Over rolling land along E. side of old road, bearing N. and W. from fence cor.

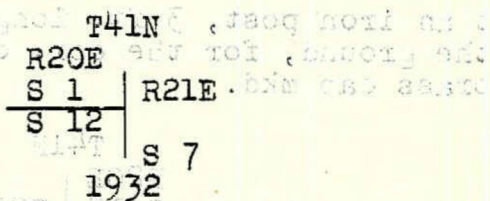

Proportionate point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 1 and 12 only, with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

This cor. stands at the west edge of very dense tall sagebrush undergrowth; lands lying immediately to the west have been cleared of all undergrowth.

Land, gentle rolling and nearly level bottoms. Soil, sandy to fine gravelly clay loam, 2nd and 3rd rate over a solidly packed gravel and rock subsoil. Undergrowth, tall dense sagebrush, buckbrush, yellow top. No timber.

From the cor. of secs. 1 and 12,

N. 0°45' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1,

Over nearly level land thru very dense undergrowth at east edge of clearing.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, with brass cap mkd.

Land, rolling and gentle W. slope of bottom lands. Soil, sandy loam, 2nd and 3rd rate, with closely packed gravelly subsoil. Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, yellow top.
