

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T 41 N, R 21 E.

Chains

Descend 75 ft. along a NE slope to the draw.

43.00

Enter bottom land, edge bears NW and SE.

46.80

Old road, bears NW and SE.

48.90

Draw, drains S 30° E, ascend 105 ft. along a NW slope.

52.10

Leave bottom land and enter low, rolling hills, edge bears NW and SE.

68.90

Spur, projects SE, descend 45 ft. over an E slope.

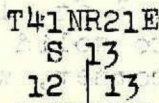
71.50

Wash, 5 ft. wide and 3 ft. deep in the bottom of a broad draw about 3 chs. wide and draining S, ascend 155 ft. along a SW slope to the closing corner.

80.00

On a SW slope; over a cross (X) cut into bedrock:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in diameter; 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for the corner of lots 12 and 13 in section 13, with brass cap marked:

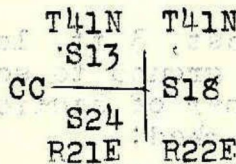

Intersect the range line between Ranges 21 and 22 East at a point 12.25 chains N 5°59' E of the 1/4 section corner of section 18, hereinafter described, and, at the point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 2 ins. in diameter, 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for the closing corner of sections 13 and 24, with brass cap marked:



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Deposit a stone, 8 x 6 x 4 ins., marked with a cross (X) at the base of the post.

Land, gently rolling hills, general S exposure and drainage.

Soil, shallow gravelly clay on the hills and a deep sandy to gravelly clay loam in the draws, 2nd and 3rd rates.

Timber, none.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and yellow top.

Good grazing.
