

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SUBDIVISION OF T. 41 N., R. 21 E.

Chains

East, on true line, bet. secs. 12 and 13.  
Over rolling land through scattered undergrowth of sagebrush and yellow top, descend 185 ft. along a general SE. slope to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

23.00 Ridge, bears NW. and SE.; continue descent.

40.00 On NE. slope.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

70.55 Draw, small stream of good water in bottom, drains south, ascend 265 ft. along a general SW. slope to the ridge.

75.18 Intersect line 6-7 of Tract No. 38, at a point 9.08 chs. north of Cor. No. 7, hereinafter described.

80.00 On SW. slope, over a cross (X) cut into the solid rock:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a mound of stone for cor. of lots 11 and 12 in sec. 12 and lots 1 and 2 in section 13 with brass cap marked

At the point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, T. 41 N., R. 21 E., with brass cap marked
