INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T 41 N, R 21 E.

Chains

Deposit a trachyte stone, 8 x 6 x 6 ins., marked with a cross (X) at the base of the post.

Land, steep mountain slopes, general S exposure and drainage.

Soil, gravelly to rocky sand, 3rd rate.

Timber, none.

Undergrowth, sagebrush. Bunch grass.

Fair grazing.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12.

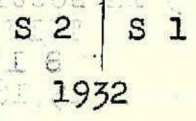
North, on sectional guide meridian, between sections 1 and 2.

Over mountainous land through a medium dense undergrowth of sagebrush; ascend 150 ft. along a SW slope.

35.90 Ridge, bears NW and SE, descend 15 ft. along a N slope.

40.00 On a N slope:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 1 in. in diameter, 26 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for the 1/4 section corner, with brass cap marked:



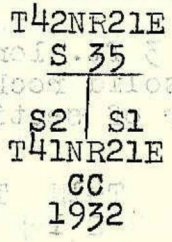
Deposit a trachyte stone, 12 x 8 x 6 ins., marked with a cross (X) at the base of the post.

Descend 120 ft. along a NW slope.

65.80 Draw, drains S 30° W, ascend 50 ft. along a SW slope.

75.76 Intersect the north boundary of the township at a point 17.96 chains S 89°21' E of the original corner of sections 2, 3, 34, and 35, now remonumented as the corner of sections 34 and 35, T 42 N, R 21 E only and heretofore described: At the point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 2 ins. in diameter, 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for the closing corner of sections 1 and 2, with brass cap marked:



Deposit a trachyte stone, 12 x 9 x 8 ins., marked with a cross (X) at the base of the post.
