Descend 110 ft. along a rocky NW slope.

64.60 Draw, drains S 70° W, ascend 25 ft. along a S slope.

69.70 Spur, projects W, continue along a gentle W slope.

76.67 Intersect the north boundary of the township at a point 20.46 chains S 89°19' E of the original corner of sections 3, 4, 33, and 34, now remonumented as the corner of sections 33 and 34, T 42 N, R 21 E, heretofore described, and at the point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long and 2 ins. in diameter, 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for the <sup>closing</sup> corner of sections 2 and 3, T 41 N, R 21 E, with brass cap marked:

40.00 Set a temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner.

84.49 Intersect the 8th Standard Parallel North at a point 02 lks. west of the standard corner of sections 33 and 34, heretofore described, and from that corner:

N 0°02' W, on true line, between sections 33 and 34.

Over mountainous land, through a medium dense undergrowth of sagebrush, ascend 45 ft. along a gentle SW slope.
