

## INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 41 N., R. 21 E.

Chains

22.40 Bottom of large flat draw, drains S. from N.; continue gradual descent over S. slope to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Ascend 20 ft. over gentle E. slope.

65.20 Small spur, projects S.; descend 10 ft. over gentle W. slope.

68.24 Intersect the W. bdy. of the township, N.  $0^{\circ}43'$  E., 9.73 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 24 and 25, T. 41 N., R. 20 E., heretofore described.

At point of intersection:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, T. 41 N., R. 21 E., with brass cap marked

Deposit a stone, 6 x 4 x 2 ins., at base of post, marked with a cross (X), and raise a mound of stone around post

Land, rolling and mountainous, with a general southwesterly exposure and drainage.

Soil, shallow loose sand underlaid with gravel and rock; 3rd rate.

Undergrowth, sage, yellow top, bunch grass and buck brush.

No timber.

Fair grazing land.

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From the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29, and 30.

N.  $0^{\circ}03'$  W., bet. secs. 19 and 20.

Over rolling mountainous land through dense undergrowth; ascend 40 ft. over gradual rocky SW. slope.

10.60 Spur, projects W.; descend 20 ft. over NW. slope.

18.30 Draw, drains W.; from N.  $80^{\circ}$  E.; ascend 270 ft. over SW. slope.

38.20 Spur, projects S.  $70^{\circ}$  W.; descend 25 ft. over NW. slope to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
