

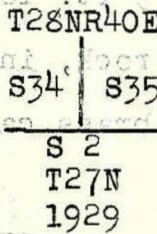
Subdivisions T. 27 N., R. 40 E.

Chains



- 40.45 Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor. Road, bears NE. and SW.
- 42.50 Shallow draw, drains W.
- 57.00 Main Jersey Valley Road, bears N.  $65^\circ$  E. and S.  $65^\circ$  W.
- 65.00 Draw, drains W.
- 72.00 Shallow draw, drains W.
- 75.53 Intersect N. boundary of township, 6.94 chs. W. of the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, which is a 2 in. iron post, firmly set in the ground, and marked and witnessed as described in the official records of the survey of

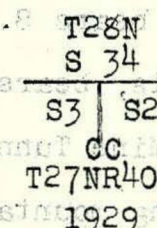
T. 28 N., R. 40 E., I remark same to read



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

At point of intersection

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. dia., 27 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap



Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, rolling mountainous. Soil, clay sandy loam, 3rd. rate.

Timber, none. Undergrowth, sage, shadscale, buckbrush.

General drainage, W. Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on S. boundary of twp.

N.  $0^\circ 02'$  W., between secs. 33 and 34

Over mountainous land

Asc. gentle SW. slope
