

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF EAST BDY. OF T. 21 N., R. 20 E.

## Chains

37.90	Draw, drains W., asc. along SW. slope.
40.35	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7 and 12, which is a granite stone, 7x8x8 ins. above ground, firmly set in the center of an old embedded mound of earth and stone, marked " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on SW. face. At point for cor. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone deposited at base, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd. S12   S7 1935 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. N. 0° 32' E., bet. secs. 7 and 12.
3.45	Saddle in spur ridge projecting N. 70° W. from E. Desc. 90 ft. over N. slope.
15.75	Draw, drains NW., asc. 70 ft. over SW. slope.
19.35	End of a rocky spur from the SE.
24.85	Spur, slopes W., desc. 30 ft. over N. slope.
28.95	Main draw, drains W., asc. 140 ft. over S. slope.
40.56	The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, which is a granite stone, 10x10x22 ins., loosely set in the center of a wide, low mound of stone, marked with 5 notches on S. edge and 1 notch on N. edge. At point for cor. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock, over a cross (x), with the original stone deposited at base, and in a mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd. T21N R20E R21E S1   S6 S12   S7 1935 raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, around post.
	Land, hilly. Soil, shallow sandy to gravelly surface soil, 3rd rate, over rocky subsoil. Timber, very scattering scrubby juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush, mountain rush. Grazing, fair.
	N. 0° 04' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6, Over broken hilly land through dense undergrowth and scattering scrubby juniper timber. Asc. 60 ft. over S. slope.
