Chains

East, on a true line bet. secs. 27 and 34.

Over mountainous land, through widely scattered timber and dense undergrowth; desc. 135 ft. over an E. slope.

3.85 Bottom of a rocky draw, draining S. 60° E.; asc. gentle SE. slope.

12.20 Spur, projects S. 60° E.; about 6 chs. to end; desc. 470 ft. to the 1/4 sec. cor., along the N. side of a draw draining E.

30.00 Point of a spur, projecting from the N. 80° W.; desc. over an E. slope.

32.40 Draw, drains S. 60° E.

38.00 Point of a spur, projecting from the NW.; desc. along an E. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

40.90 Bottom of a small draw, draining S. 60° E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of secs. 27 and 34, with brass cap mkd.

From this cor. the 335th Mile Cor. bears S. 1°28' E., 20.435 chs. dist.; an iron post, 3 ins. diam., mkd. and witnessed as heretofore described.

Land, rolling mountains; E. exposure and drainage. Soil, shallow, gravelly loam; 3rd rate. Timber, widely scattered juniper and pinon. Undergrowth, creosote, cacti, yucca and sage brush. Bunch grass. Fair grazing.
